FIORI DRIVE TRAFFIC CONTROL

Recommendation

Councillor DiVona recommends:

- 1. That the petition from the residents of Fiori Drive with respect to traffic calming measures on Fiori Drive, be received; and
- 2. That Vaughan Council direct Engineering staff to attend a public meeting.

<u>Purpose</u>

To address Fiori Drive traffic control.

Background - Analysis and Options

The residents are dealing with high speeding vehicles including motorbikes and scooters on Fiori Drive. These drivers are continually ignoring the stop signs and the rate of speed they are travelling is in excess of 60 kms/hr. The problem generally increases between 4 p.m. and 10 p.m. and converging at a strip mall at Fiori Drive and Chancellor Road.

Conclusion

The residents of Fiori Drive and neighbouring street request changes to Fiori Drive in order to reduce the high speeds of vehicles. A petition was completed in 1980's, which resulted in the addition of one stop sign at the intersection of Fiori Drive and Adrianno Crescent. This however is not resolving the existing problem of excessive speeding and increased traffic flow.
