**TORRAN ROAD  
PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT**

**Recommendation**

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT the speed limit on Torran Road be reduced to 40km/hr. from Kiloran Avenue to Firglen Ridge.

**Purpose**

To maintain a safe speed throughout the length of Torran Road, in response to residents' concerns.

**Background**

Recently, area residents tried to form a Traffic Calming Committee, with assistance from the Engineering Department, in the Firglen Ridge area. Although there was not enough support for any in-depth traffic calming measures, everyone was in agreement that speeding vehicles were a problem on Torran Road. Torran Road is a link between the northern and southern sections of this residential area.

**Conclusion**

In response to requests received from area residents' concerns with respect to speeding vehicles, it is recommended that the speed limit on Torran Road be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr. between Kiloran Avenue and Firglen Ridge.
