AVDELL AVENUE & ST. MICHELE PLACE (WEST ENTRANCE)
3-WAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

In response to requests from area residents, Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT a three-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Avdell Avenue and St. Michele Place (west entrance), pending inspection by Engineering Department staff to determine the appropriate placement of signposts with respect to driveway obstructions.

Purpose

To reduce and control speeds along Avdell Avenue and to encourage motorists exiting St. Michele Place to exercise caution when proceeding onto Avdell Avenue.

Background

Avdell Avenue is a busy street with motorists using it as a main access road into and within the subdivision between Vaughan Mills Road and Clarence Street.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a three-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Avdell Avenue and St. Michele Place (west entrance).
