VAUGHAN MILLS ROAD AND HUMBERVIEW DRIVE 3-WAY STOP CONTROL

Council adopted the following resolution at the Council meeting of February 10, 2003, with respect to Item 15, Report No. 13, of the Committee of the Whole meeting of February 3, 2003:

The Committee of the Whole recommends that this matter be referred to the Committee of the Whole meeting of February 17, 2003, to permit further consultation with the community.

Recommendation

Councillor Linda Jackson recommends:

That a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Humberview Drive.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing a 3-way stop control at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Humberview Drive, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

Whereas, the Vaughan Mills bridge is now open to traffic, and

Whereas, area residents have expressed concerns about excessive speed and traffic infiltration along Vaughan Mills Road, and

Whereas, many motorists are using Vaughan Mills Road as a quick route between Langstaff Road, Kipling Avenue and Rutherford Road, and

Whereas, extensive road work is occurring along Rutherford Road, and

A 3-way stop control at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Humberview Drive would curtail and slow down vehicular traffic.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Vaughan Mills Road and Humberview Drive.
