MEETING HOUSE ROAD AND ROSEBURY LANE 3-WAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

Councillor Linda Jackson recommends:

That a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Meeting House Road and Rosebury Lane.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing a 3-way stop control at the intersection of Meeting House Road and Rosebury Lane, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

Whereas, previous traffic calming measures in this area have failed to reduce speeding to any significant degree, and

Whereas, excessive speeds continue to be a safety hazard to the area residents, and

Whereas, there exists a steep incline on Meeting House Road which promotes speeding, and

A 3-way stop control at the intersection of Meeting House Road and Rosebury Lane would slow motorists traveling down the hill and will encourage westbound traffic to decelerate for the existing curb adjustments.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection of Meeting House Road and Rosebury Lane.


