

**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – MARCH 24, 2003**

**ROYALPARK WAY  
PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT**

**Recommendation**

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT the speed limit on Royalpark Way be reduced to 40km/hr. between Highway 27 and Vaughan Mills Road, and

THAT staff proceed immediately with installation of appropriate signage.

**Purpose**

To reduce the speed with which motorists continue to travel throughout the length of Royalpark Way in response to requests received from area residents.

**Background**

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Royalpark Way. The existing speed is a statutory 50km/hr. and speed humps have failed to solve the problem.

**Conclusion**

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that the speed limit on Royalpark Way be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr. between Highway 27 and Vaughan Mills Road.
