**VAUGHAN MILLS ROAD
PROPOSED 40 KM/HR SPEED LIMIT**

Recommendation

Councillor Linda D. Jackson recommends:

THAT the speed limit on Vaughan Mills Road be reduced to 40km/hr. between Royalpark Way and Rutherford Road, and

THAT staff proceed immediately with installation of appropriate signage.

Purpose

To reduce the speed with which motorists continue to travel throughout the length of Vaughan Mills Road in response to requests received from area residents.

Background

Area residents have expressed concerns regarding the excessive vehicle speeds and the safety of pedestrians on Vaughan Mills Road. There have been several single vehicle accidents in the area following the opening of the Vaughan Mills Bridge. The existing speed is a statutory 50km/hr.

Conclusion

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that the speed limit on Vaughan Mills Road be reduced from 50km/hr. to 40km/hr. between Royalpark Way and Rutherford Road.
