PROMENADE PARK – NAME CHANGE

Recommendation

Councillor Sandra Yeung Racco recommends:

1. That the name of Promenade Park be changed to Pierre Elliott Trudeau Park and that this name change be submitted for approval.

Purpose

To change the park's name to reflect the historical statue that is being erected there.

Background - Analysis and Options

Currently, there is a statue of the late former Prime Minister, the right honourable Pierre Elliott Trudeau, being erected in the park, and this statue will be completed before the end of summer 2004. This is the first statue of the late former Prime Minister in the world.

Conclusion

Changing the park's name to Pierre Elliott Trudeau Park would be reflective of the monument that is being built and would encourage the preservation of a historical Canadian figure within the City of Vaughan.
