3-WAY STOP CONTROL

Recommendation

Councillor Di Vona recommends:

That Engineering staff review the possibility of installing a 3-way stop control to be installed at the intersection of Belview Avenue and Ivano Mews.

Purpose

To review the feasibility of implementing a 3-way stop control on Belview Avenue and Ivano Mews, in response to requests received from area residents.

Background - Analysis and Options

City of Vaughan has implemented traffic calming measures already in this area although the intersection of Belview Avenue and Ivano Mews is still experiencing excessive speeding and this is posing a safety hazard to the area residents, and

A 3-way stop control at the intersection of Belview Avenue and Ivano Mews would slow traffic and alleviate these traffic problems.

In response to requests received from area residents, it is recommended that a 3-way stop control be installed at the intersection on Belview Avenue and Ivano Mews.
