REQUEST FOR STAFF TO REPORT ON PARTNERING WITH EARTH RANGERS

RECOMMENDATION

Councillor Peter Meffe recommends:

That staff be directed to report on the feasibility of partnering with the Earth Rangers/Kortright Centre to provide educational and environmental programs to be made available to students in the City of Vaughan.

Purpose

The purpose of this recommendation is to provide Council with information in order to further explore the possibility of providing a new Community Program with the Earth Rangers/Kortright Centre.

Background - Analysis and Options

Each year thousands of wild animals are injured, displaced or orphaned as a result of human activity. Contaminants such as oil spills, pollution, and human encroachment all contribute to the destruction of their habitat. The responsibility in helping these animals is twofold, not only because we caused the problem, but we are both dependent on the same ecosystems.

Earth Rangers is providing immediate aid through their professional wildlife rescue, rehabilitation and research programs. While these programs are important, educating the public and behaviour modification will address the long-term issues. Aiming the program through their Youth Education Programs connect children with animals and nature and teach them that their actions can make a difference, which in turn will inspire them to make a lifelong commitment to improve the environment.
