RAYMOND ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNS

Recommendation

Councillor Carella recommends that the Commissioners of Engineering Services and Public Works provide a report to a future Committee of Whole meeting with regards:

- 1) erection of a sign on Woodbridge Ave., indicating that left turns onto Raymond Road are prohibited Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.; and
- 2) erection of a sign on Martin Grove Road, indicating that right turns onto Raymond Road are prohibited Monday to Friday, from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Purpose

To review, in response to a request received from an area resident, change of signs prohibiting left hand turns onto Raymond Road from Woodbridge Avenue and right turns from Martin Grove Road onto Raymond Road.

Background - Analysis and Options

Subsequent an initial request from a Raymond Road resident, a letter was sent to all Raymond Road residents requesting comments on the above proposals. The preponderance of responses indicated that changes were very much desired; the current state has created ongoing concerns (i.e. residents having to go a circuitous route during off peak hours, and drivers committing illegal left turns and speeding).

Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2007

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council and the necessary resources have been allocated and approved.

Conclusion

It is recommended that changes to the traffic signs be implemented at Raymond Road and Woodbridge Avenue, and Raymond Road and Martin Grove Road.
