### **INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS**

#### **Recommendation**

That Staff prepare a report addressing the need for a two-way stop on Bainbridge Avenue, at the intersection of Roxana Avenue

#### **Purpose**

To improve pedestrian safety in and around the precincts of St. Peter's Church

#### **Background - Analysis and Options**

A twenty-year resident of Woodbridge recently lost her life crossing Bainbridge Avenue at Roxana, due no doubt to a combination of weather, time of day, and traffic speed. At the request of the pastor of the nearby church---which is the focus of a great deal of pedestrian and vehicular traffic---staff is asked to study whether the addition of two-way stop signs on Bainbridge is appropriate.

#### **Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2007**

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council---including the safety of the citizenry---and the necessary resources have been allocated and approved.

#### **Conclusion**

On the basis of technical studies, staff will determine if pedestrian and vehicular safety will be enhanced by the installation of two-way stop controls on Bainbridge Avenue at Roxana Avenue.
