To respond to the request received from Aids Committee of York Region.

Background - Analysis and Options

The correspondence received from Aids Committee of York Region, dated November 1, 2005, is attached (Attachment #1).

The proclamation request meets the requirements of the City's Proclamation Policy: That upon request, the City of Vaughan issue proclamations for events, campaigns or other similar matters: which are promoted by any organization that is a registered charity pursuant to Section 248 of the Income Tax Act".

Aids Committee of York Region has requested the City publicize this proclamation to recognize the impact of HIV/AIDS and the need for tolerance, understanding and prevention.

The Corporate Communications Department posts proclamations issued by the City on the City's website under "Events – Proclamations". Publishing proclamations on the City Page depends on space availability. Corporate Communications will, given sufficient lead-time, issue news releases in support of the proclamation.

Canadian HIV/AIDS Awareness Week World AIDS Day November 24 – December 1, 2005



WHEREAS the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS) estimates that more than 40 million people are infected with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) worldwide,

WHEREAS UNAIDS has called upon governments, organizations and individuals to Recognize the week of November 24 to December 1, 2005 as HIV/AIDS Awareness Week and World AIDS Day with the theme "One person can make a difference", the goals of which are:

- X to raise awareness of HIV/AIDS, challenge discrimination towards those affected or infected with HIV/AIDS,
- X to challenge stigma and discrimination based on gender, sexual orientation, culture, ethnicity and race as it relates to HIV/AIDS, and
- X to promote and support HIV prevention efforts.

WHEREAS every day in Canada, 11 people are infected with HIV, and unfortunately, thousands of Canadians still face HIV-related stigma and discrimination.

WHEREAS the number of Canadians living with HIV/AIDS continues to increase with approximately 4,200 new infections each year,

WHEREAS in the absence of a cure or vaccine, education is our only defense against HIV/AIDS, and

WHEREAS Canadian HIV/AIDS Awareness Week and World AIDS Day offer an opportunity to enhance tolerance and understanding while communicating prevention information about the epidemic,
