Purpose

Background - Analysis and Options

The attached request to proclaim the week of September 18, 2006 as Lazio Week in the City of Vaughan was forwarded by the President, Lazio Federation of Ontario. Activities will showcase various aspects of Lazio's socio-economic and cultural fabric, including representation of the business, tourism, cultural, and artistic patrimony of this area of Italy.

It should be noted that The City of Vaughan shares friendship with this area of Italy as the City has twinned with the City of Sora which is in the Region of Lazio.
