TRAFFIC CALMING – CARL TENNEN STREET

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works recommends:

Communications Plan

Engineering staff held a Public Meeting with the Local Councillor and the residents of Carl Tennen Street on Thursday, May 31, 2007. The notices were mailed out and placed on the City's web page. Also, the notices were advertised in the following papers: Vaughan Weekly, Vaughan Citizen, and Lo Specchio.

Purpose

To advise Council of the status of the Carl Tennen Street Traffic Calming Committee

Background - Analysis and Options

At its meeting on April 2, 2007, Council directed:

- “1. That staff and the Local Councillor meet with the local community to discuss traffic calming for Carl Tennen Street;**
- 2. That staff review the need for and feasibility of traffic calming measures for Carl Tennen Street; and**
- 3. That staff report to a future Committee of the Whole meeting.”**

Staff held a meeting with the community on Thursday, May 31, 2007. At that meeting, the residents were advised of traffic calming measures available to them. The residents formed a traffic committee. Staff provided the committee members with the engineering drawings for Carl Tennen Street, and the engineering specifications for traffic calming measures. The traffic committee is currently working on their plan. Please see Attachment No. 1 for area network.
