AWARD OF TENDER T07- 249 <u>TENNIS COURT RESURFACING AT VAUGHAN CREST PARK, JOEY PANETTA PARK,</u> WADE GATE PARK, DUFFERIN DISTRICT PARK, AND HEFHILL PARK

Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services, in consultation with the Directors of Reserves and Investments, Purchasing Services and Parks Development, recommends:

- 1) That T07-249, Tennis Court Resurfacing at Vaughan Crest Park, Joey Panetta Park, Wade Gate Park, Dufferin District Park, and Hefhill Park be awarded to Serve Construction Ltd. For the amount of \$143,700.50 (excluding G.S.T.); and
- 2) That a contingency allowance of \$20,000.00 be approved, within which the Director of Parks Development is authorized to approve amendments to the contract; and,
- 3) That a bylaw be enacted authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to sign the necessary documents.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to award tender T07-249 for Tennis Court Resurfacing at Vaughan Crest Park, Joey Panetta Park, Wade Gate Park, Dufferin District Park, and Hefhill Park.

Background - Analysis and Options

The project is for the resurfacing of five (5) existing tennis courts: Vaughan Crest Park, 300 Pinewood Drive, Ward 5; Joey Panetta Park, 88 Marieta St., Ward 3; Wade Gate Park, 151 Wade Gate, Ward 4; Dufferin District Park, 1441 Clark Avenue West, Ward 4, and; Hefhill Park, 27 Hefhill Court, Ward 5. Capital project PK-6112-07 – Tennis Court Resurfacing funding was approved in the 2007 budget. The resurfacing involves the application of an acrylic coating to the existing asphalt to provide a uniform surface finish that will extend the life cycle of the courts.

This tender was publicly advertised in the Daily Commercial News and through the Electronic Tender Network (ETN) and the Ontario Public Buyers Association (OBPA). The tender was publicly opened on Monday, October 22, 2007. Nine (9) sets of bid documents were issued. Two (2) bid documents were received. The bid results are as follows:
