(i) which are promoted by any organization that is a registered charity pursuant to Section 248 of the Income Tax Act". The UJA Federation of Greater Toronto is a registered charity.

The Canadian Jewish Congress on behalf of UJA Federation of Greater Toronto has requested the City to proclaim the week of August 21, 2011 as "United Jewish Appeal of Greater Toronto Week" which coincides with the launch of their annual campaign. The UJA Federation of Greater Toronto is the city's principal Jewish community organization responsible for fundraising, allocations to numerous non-profit agencies, planning and community development. The UJA Federation and its affiliated agencies assist many Canadians of all backgrounds and faiths, combating anti-Semitism and racism in all its forms, revitalizing Jewish community structures and services, fortifying Jewish identity and fostering strong ties with Israel.
