LANGSTAFF ROAD, ROAD NAME CHANGE

Recommendation

- 1) That any deputations on the matter be received; and
- 2) That a By-law be enacted to change the name of a portion of Langstaff Road to Maple Sugar Lane

Purpose

To enact a by-law to change the name of a portion of Langstaff Road to Maple Sugar Lane.

Background – Analysis and Options

Council, at its meeting of June 25, 2001, resolved that the necessary steps be taken to change a portion of Langstaff Road to Maple Sugar Lane.

The notice for the proposed road name change was subsequently advertised for four (4) consecutive weeks in the Liberal as required in the Municipal Act. A copy of the notice is attached.

The appropriate agencies have been notified of the proposed by-law. No objections were received.

A reference plan is required to enact the renaming by-law. Should Council resolve to rename the road, a by-law will be brought to a future Council meeting after the reference plan is completed.

Conclusion

In order to complete the road name change process, Council's approval of this recommendation is required.

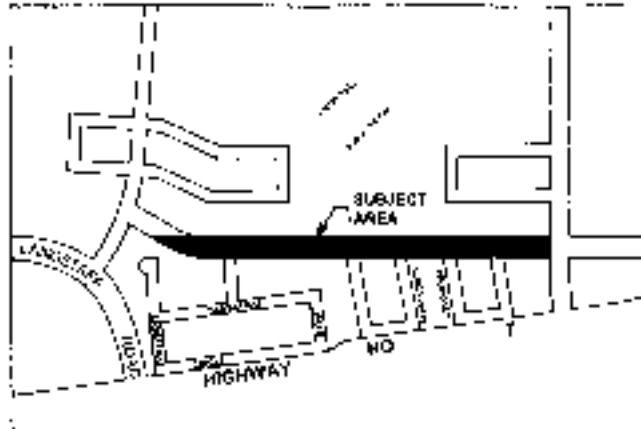
