REQUEST FOR NOISE EXEMPTION
KLEINBURG PINES DRIVING RANGE
BINDERTWINE FESTIVAL – SEPT. 6-8, 2002

Recommendation

The City Clerk recommends that a noise exemption be granted until 2:00 A.M. on Friday Sept.6 and Saturday Sept.7, 2002 to accommodate live entertainment for the Bindertwine Festival.

Purpose

To extend the noise exemption from 1:00A.M. to 2:00A.M. on September 6 and 7, 2002.

Background - Analysis and Options

A request has been received from the owner of the Kleinburg Pines Driving Range for an exemption of the City's Noise By-law to accommodate Bindertwine festivities on Sept.6, 7 and 8. On May 27, 2002 Council adopted a report which allows for a noise exemption for special events up to 11:00P.M. on weekdays and 1:00A.M. on Saturdays and on evenings before a holiday subject to an application made for a Special Events Permit. The owner has submitted an application for a special event permit. Staff is recommending that an exemption be granted for Sept.6 and 7 to allow the playing of music until 2:00A.M. Staff does not support an exemption for Sept.8 as the next day is a regular work day. Accordingly, live entertainment should cease at 11:00P.M. on Sunday Sept.8,2002.

Conclusion

That a noise exemption be granted on Sept. 6 and 7,2002 until 2:00A.M. to accommodate live entertainment for the Bindertwine Festival.
