### **PART OF MEMORIAL HILL DRIVE ROAD ALLOWANCE ROAD CLOSURE**

#### **Recommendation**

The City Clerk recommends:

- 1) That any deputations on the matter be received; and
- 2) That a By-law be enacted to Stop-up, Close and Convey part of the Memorial Hill Drive road allowance.

#### **Purpose**

To enact a by-law to stop-up, close and convey part of Memorial Hill Drive Road allowance.

#### **Economic Impact**

The City of Vaughan shall receive funds in the total amount of \$117,000.00, plus appraisal, survey and road closure costs from the sale of this property.

#### **Background – Analysis and Options**

At its meeting of May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009, Council directed staff to commence procedures as required by the Municipal Act to advertise and schedule a Public Hearing to stop-up, close and convey part of the Memorial Hill Drive road allowance.

The notice (Attachment 1) was advertised for two (2) consecutive weeks (June 18th & June 26th, 2009) in the City Page of the following papers: Vaughan Today and Vaughan Citizen/Liberal. The appropriate agencies have been notified of the proposed by-law. No objections have been received.

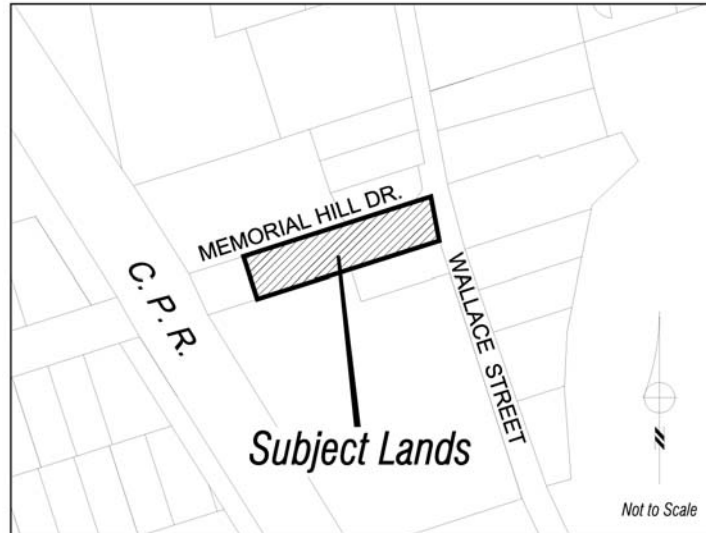
