The following items were dealt with:

#### 1 PARKS AND FORESTRY OPERATIONS – WORKING TOWARDS A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

The Environment Committee recommends:

- 1) That the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Community Services, dated January 26, 2010, be approved;
- 2) That staff be requested to bring forward a report on initiatives such as the creation of a community gardens pilot project and the education strategy for the Vaughan B'leaves program;
- That staff be requested to prepare a report with respect to banning all electronics from onstreet waste pick-up and that proper information on this initiative be provided to residents, including locations where these items can be properly disposed;
- 4) That as part of its 2010 work plan, staff report back on a plan for a public garden to demonstrate sustainability measures that may be employed by owners of private residential properties, including but not limited to the following features:
  - (i) the inclusion of native species only
  - (ii) drought resistant plant types
  - (iii) lawn-less gardening

and the identification of potential sites on public lands or private property (at negligible cost) that are highly accessible and visible to both pedestrian and motor traffic, e.g. the new Civic Centre; and

5) That the presentation material submitted entitled, "Parks & Forestry Operations 2010 Work Plan. Working Towards a Sustainable Future", be received.
